 - Number of volunteer hours
 - Number of brothers involved. Council's volunteer efforts.
- Publicity:
 - Program Awareness
 - Parish/Community/Brother Involvement
- Effectiveness of the program:
 - Who benefits from the project?
 - Does the activity demonstrate the objectives of the Council Services Program
- Results:
 - What were the benefits derived from sponsorship of this council project?
 - Program Originality?
 - How did the project results affect the Council Services Program?
