NECROLOGY REPORT:

Is due April 1, 2017 – The names of those members who have died since the last State Annual General Meeting should also be sent to the State Secretary, using the Necrology Report form which was included with the First Convention Call. Only those names received on this Necrology Report will be included on the report, which will be read at the Necrology Mass on Saturday, April 29, 2017. MEMBERSHIP REPORT:

Is due April 1, 2017 – The **Financial Secretary** should submit this form, also included in the First Convention Call, to the State Secretary. The Membership report, showing council membership statistics at March 31, will be circulated in order that the convention delegates may make necessary comparisons with Supreme Council's figures. ACCOMMODATION:

State Officers, Past State Deputies, District Deputies, State Chairmen/Directors, and Grand Knights should have received official information from the Convention Committee.

REGISTRATION:

Past State Deputies, District Deputies, State Chairmen/Directors, and delegates should present, upon arrival, their official Credential Forms to those persons working at the Knights of Columbus registration desk at the convention.

CEREMONIAL ROBES:

State Officers, Past State Deputies, District Deputies and Grand Knights are directed by the State Deputy to be robed appropriately for the Opening Mass and Opening Ceremonies.

JEWEL OF OFFICE:

The appropriate Jewel of Office is to be brought to the convention and **worn** at all sessions.

COMMITTEE MEETINGS:

Committee meetings and meetings of the State Officers, District Deputies and State Directors all commence on **Friday afternoon**. Grand Knights should refer to the enclosed listing of Convention Committees; to see if their Council has been assigned to a committee. Those Grand Knights selected to chair a committee should contact Edgar Ursua, Convention Chairman by April 15, 2017 for a meeting room if required. Meeting Rooms will be posted at the Convention Registration Desk. The Committee Chairman should also contact each member of his committee to ensure that all are aware of their responsibilities and of the time and place of the committee meeting.

STATE BANQUET:

Notice is hereby given that the State Deputy's Banquet is an official function of the State Convention. State Officers, District Deputies, State Directors, and Council Delegates are under obligation to attend in order to qualify for mileage and per diem allowances.
