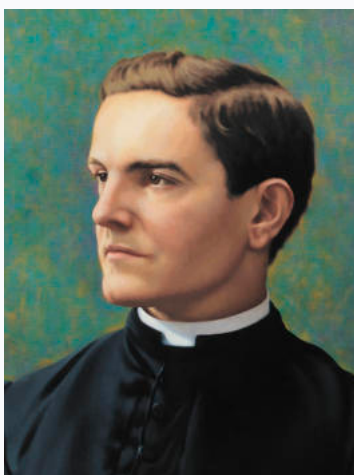

Once the checks are received and cleared, Brother Arcie Lim will forward them to the State Treasurer, Brother Jim Williams, at jimw.kofc@gmail.com, to place orders for coats from Supreme. The submission deadline has been extended to **September 30, 2025**. Both the order form and payment must be received by that date.
